Ridgewood Commons will continue to be a home for mutual aid, community building, and a space for collective thought & experimentation in Ridgewood, Queens.

Ridgewood Commons operates under a democratic spokes council governance model, with the goal of fostering cooperative skill building, diverse community representation and influence, and organizational resilience.

We host free community programs and projects year-round, including: a Food Pantry, Communal Sunday Dinners, Film Screenings, a Community Gym, Yoga & Meditation, a Maker Space, a Writers' Workshop, Reading Groups, Arts & Crafts Workshops, a CSA, plus Talks and other skill-sharing and educational events.

Anyone interested can join.

The space can also be rented for a variety of purposes: from presentations and workshops, to parties and as a film/photography shooting location.
